SUSPENSION OF LIMITED FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES DUE TO ALERT LEVEL 3

To: OIC-Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Public School Principals All Others Concerned

- 1. This is to announce the suspension of the implementation of Batch 1 of limited face-to-face classes in SDO Bataan due to the classification of the Province of Bataan as under Alert Level 3 by the Inter-Agency Task Force for Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) from January 9-15, 2022.
- 2. The conduct of limited face-to-face classes shall only commence upon the downgrading to Alert Level 2 as stipulated in the IATF guidelines.
- 3. Schools are still expected to continue their preparations for the limited face-toface classes but with the highest levels of caution and observing all applicable protocols for the current alert level.
- 4. Moreover, all schools and offices are reminded that under Alert Level 3, agencies and instrumentalities of the government shall remain fully operational and shall adhere to at least 60% onsite reporting.
- 5. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
