

1st CALL FOR FY 2022 RESEARCH PROPOSALS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. In accordance with the Department's goal to promote and strengthen the culture of research in basic education, DepEd Regional Office III, through the Policy, Planning and Research Division, announces the 1st Call for FY 2022 Research Proposals under the Policy Research Program (PRP) Fund (formerly Basic Education Research Fund).
- 2. All research proposals must be anchored on the Regional Memorandum No. 185 s. 2020 known as the Harmonized Regional Basic Education Research Agenda. Interested teaching, teaching-related, and non-teaching personnel may submit research proposals on the following areas: a) Teaching and Learning; b) Child Protection; c) Human Resource Development; d) Governance; e) Gender and Development; f) Disaster Risk Reduction and Management; and g) Inclusive Education.
- 3. In addition, research that will be conducted should convey information on raising the quality of education in Region III and be anchored on the Basic Education Learning Continuity Operational Plan as well as on the four pillars of Sulong Edukalidad: (1) K to 12 Curriculum review and update; (2) Improvement of the learning environment; (3) Teachers' upskilling and reskilling; and (4) Engagement of stakeholders for support and collaboration. Correspondingly, the study should also contribute to the effective delivery of the K-12 Curriculum through the expanded limited face-to-face classes, focusing on four critical interrelated areas: 1. Access to education 2. Quality and inclusive learning 3. Well-being (Mental health and psychosocial support) 4. Safe schools.
- 4. The School Governance Operations Division (SGOD) Chief Education Supervisor shall take the lead in the initial screening of submitted proposals for compliance with the submission guidelines. The Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC), chaired by the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, shall evaluate, approve and endorse proposals to the Regional Office for









confirmation and release of funds under PRPF. The Senior Education Program Specialist (SEPS) in Planning and Research shall upload all the reviewed and approved research proposals through this link http://bit.ly/prpfro3. The link is not allowed to be shared with research proponents. The use of an electronic signature is acceptable for all documents.
