

AB\$TRACT SUBMISSION

To present at the conference, your abstract must first pass a "double-blind" peer review process. Please take note of the following:

Guide for Paper Presenters:

- 1. Submit an extended abstract of your paper (around 1,500 to 2,000 words) with the following parts:
 - a. Title of paper
 - b. Author's name, name of institution, highest educational attainment, email address/contact information
 - c. Short introduction
 - d. Main body (that includes a concise review of literature methodology, discussion and summary of findings)
 - e. Conclusion
 - f. References
- 2. Send your extended abstract to the email addless: icvre@dlsud.edu.ph
- 3. Your proposal will normally be reviewed within two weeks through a double-blind peer review process.
- 4. If your paper is accepted, you will receive a confirmation email from the ICVRE 2022 organizing committee.
- 5. You must submit a pre-recorded video of your presentation. The video file must be in MP4 format, landscape orientation, and with a maximum duration of 20 minutes. Please check the quality of your video before uploading. It is recommended that your video includes a window box with the speaking presenter, instead of a voice-over presentation only. Send your video to: icvre@dlsud.edu.ph
- 6. You must be available for a short Q and A during your presentation timeslot.
- 7. After the conference, we invite you to submit a copy of your full paper to the DLSUD journal Academia Lasalliana Journal of Education and Humanities for it to undergo the review process for publication. Please take note that this is optional and although the organizing committee will recommend your paper, it does not automatically make your paper acceptable for publication.


