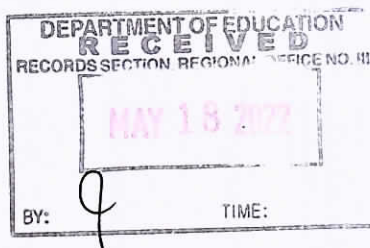

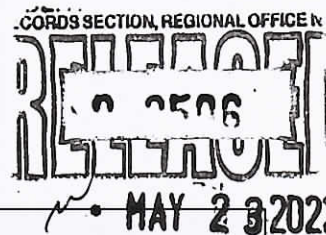

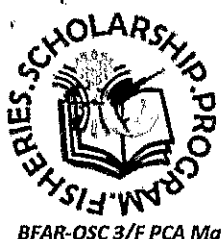

2. Any ALS/HS/SHS graduates/graduating students;
3. Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, whether or not he has earned any units in college;
4. Bona fide member of an ethno-linguistic group in his/her community duly recognized by the NCIP;
5. For ALS/high school graduate applicants the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 80%;
6. For graduating students under K to 12 program, Grade 11 GWA shall not be lower than 80% or its equivalent;
7. Of good moral character as certified by the School Head/Principal and Community Resident Leader;
8. Parent(s)/guardian(s) or the applicant must be physically residing in the municipality/ICCs of the Region for at least six (6) months, where the slot of the scholarship program is allotted;
9. Parent(s)/guardian(s) must be a member of a particular tribe recognized by the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NSIP).
10. Must come from the clan of "Pamulalakaw" (in charge of waters and water resources) certified by the Indigenous Political Structure (IPs) and Community Leader
