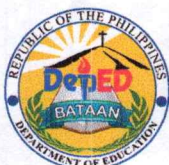

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

ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS  
WEEK**

DATE : March 5, 2021

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In reference to Section 4 of Administrative Order (AO) No. 23 s. 2011, titled "Creating a Steering Committee on National Observances," states that committee member agencies, which include the Department of Education (DepEd), have the following power and functions:

- a) Formulate, organize and prescribe the manner of yearly celebrations of historical events;



- b) Draw up mechanism among various national departments, local government units, and the private sector for the effective mobilization and coordination of commemorative programs;
- c) Monitor, evaluate and submit quarterly reports to the president on all programs of the committee; and
- d) Perform such other powers and functions as may be necessary to carry out the provision of this Administrative Order.

Further, Section 5 of the same AO states that "all other government agencies are hereby directed to cooperate with and fully support the committee." Thus, all departments, agencies, bureaus, offices, national government agencies (NGAs), local government units (LGUs) and government-owned and controlled corporations (GOCCs) are required to give full support, assistance and cooperation to the National Steering Committee (NSC), chaired by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) in the exercise of its responsibilities and functions to achieve the objectives of abovementioned celebrations.

In support of the upcoming commemoration, DepEd through the External Partnerships Service (EPS) and in cooperation with the NHCP, shall conduct virtual symposium on the **79th Anniversary of Araw ng Kagitingan and Philippine Veterans Week** on **April 9, 2021** from **4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.** A National Poster-Making and Oratorical Contests will also be held as part of the celebrations. Judging and Awarding of winners for the Poster-Making Contest and Oratorical Contest will be held the week after the Symposium (TBA).

In this regard, we would like to respectfully request from your region and the Schools Division Office of Bataan, **the acceptance of hosting the event and assistance** for the successful implementation of said program and activities.

The EPS-Special Events Unit (SEU) shall coordinate with your offices for the preparation, actual conduct, and evaluation of the said activity. Appropriate funds shall be downloaded to DepEd Division of Bataan for this purpose, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
