Warm greetings!

Our organization Knowledge Community, Inc., a non-profit organization, is pleased to continue the partnership with DepEd Schools Division of Bataan on the pilot program for science education teachers. In 2019, DepEd nominated five divisions to participate in a pilot program for science education teachers namely Bataan, Batangas, Olongapo, Quezon, Zambales. Based on this nomination, DepEd Bataan Grades 6 and 9 teachers from seven (7) elementary schools and three (3) junior high schools (see list below) participated in the **Science Boot Camp for Teachers 2019** in **Subic Bay Travelers Hotel, Subic Bay Freeport Zone**.

This year due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the new normal, we decided to help teachers adjust to the online/blended learning conditions, by converting all the printed materials to online materials. In addition, we added other teaching materials like teaching guides, teaching samples, quizzes and activities and videos. These materials are based on DepEd's science education curriculum for Grades 6 and 9. The materials focus on climate science, renewable and non-renewable sources of energy, energy production, and the use of natural gas for electricity generation.

Training Objective:

The objective of the online training is to orient Grades 6 and 9 science teachers on how to effectively use and maximize the online resources for teaching climate science, energy production, and the use of natural gas for electricity generation.

3. Limay National High School


