The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) hereby disseminates the announcement of the Global Center for Good Governance in Tobacco Control (GGTC) that the extension of the deadline for submission of entries to the Global Media Competition (GMC) has been extended anew to 14 May 2021.
