

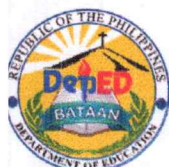

The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) hereby disseminates the announcement of the Global Center for Good Governance in Tobacco Control (GGTC) that the extension of the deadline for submission of entries to the Global Media Competition (GMC) has been extended anew to **14 May 2021**.

In this regard, the OUA reiterates the following information about the GMC, which was first disseminated through OUA Memorandum 00-0521-0036:

1. HealthJustice Philippines, on behalf of the GGTC, is inviting **DepEd learners, personnel, and stakeholders** to join the second GMC with the theme **Lies & Cover-Ups: Time to Make Tobacco Pay**.
2. The competition aims to welcome graphic material submissions as memes, GIFs, digital stickers, posters, infographics, and short videos that portray tobacco industry manipulation which undermines health policies and helps the tobacco industry escape liability from enormous burdens it has caused. Submissions can be made until **14 May 2021**.
