

# Spoken Word Challenge

## Guidelines

1. Spoken poetry is a performance art that is word based. It is a writing that meant to be spoken or delivered with emotions an audience. It is an oral art that focuses on the aesthetics of world play, rhythm, and provisions, rhyme, intonation, and voice inflection.
2. On the celebration of the 123rd Philippine Independence, the theme of the challenge is Ang **Marka ng Kabataang Makabansa**.
3. The piece must be related to the theme and should promote the department's core value "Makabansa" among young people.
4. The challenge is open to all students in basic education, both public and private.
5. The piece must be an original composition and could be written in English, Filipino or combination of both.
6. Each participant is given a maximum of 3-5 minutes to recite or deliver his/her piece. No deduction shall be made if the contestant finishes the delivery in less than the maximum time frame.
7. Sounds, instrumental or musical background are allowed to compliment the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the participant opts not to have a musical background.
8. The spoken poetry piece must be wholesome, and must not contain any vulgar, obscene, and sexually aggressive language.
9. Appropriate attire must be worn during the performance.

## Guidelines

10. All participants shall register and submit their entries on YFD's official website <https://blssyfd.weebly.com/> until **June 10, 2021 at 11:59 PM**. Winners will be announced during the Kabataan at Kasarinlan Youth Forum on **June 12, 2021 at 1:30–5:00PM**.
  - a. Go to the website abovementioned.
  - b. Click on "Registration" tab.
  - c. Select Kabataan at Kasarinlan: The Philippine Day Independence Day Youth Campaign and click on "**Submit here**" tab.
  - d. Use the file name format: **Spoken Poetry \_Complete Name \_Province/Region**
11. For it to be recognized as an official entry, all participants shall post their respective entries on their personal Facebook account and must tag our Official Facebook Page – **DepEd Tayo – Youth Formation**.
12. Use the title "Kabataang Makabansa: Spoken Word Challenge" in your caption and use the hashtags **#depedkabataan2021**  
**#KabataangMakabansaChallenge #KabataanAtKasarinlan**
13. Failure to comply in any requirements set by the guidelines of the Spoken Word Challenge will automatically lead to disqualification.
14. Deliberate use of "auto-likes" is not allowed.
15. Entries will be judged according to the following criteria:  
**Online votes – 30%** (number of Facebook positive reactions)  
**Judges' Scores – 70%** (Content (20%), Delivery and Performance (20%) Originality (15%), and Coherence of Form and Structure (15%))
16. Top 3 winners of the challenge will be featured on DepEd Tayo- Youth Formation Facebook Page on June 12 during the Philippine Independence Day celebration and will also receive a digital certificate and other prizes to be given by the Youth Formation Division.

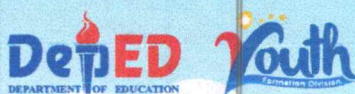

# Poster Making Challenge

## Guidelines

1. The challenge is open to all **public and private elementary and junior/senior high school students**.
2. There will be two (2) categories for the Poster Making Challenge: Traditional and Digital Poster Making.
3. For **Traditional poster**: you may pick a medium of your choice: acrylic, water-color, oil, pastel, etc.  
For **Digital poster**: you may use any application and/or gadget. Any technique or style in painting in both categories is allowed.
4. Poster shall only be composed of graphics or images. Minimum actual size of poster is 1/8 illustration board (10"x15"), in portrait or landscape layout.
5. The artwork should be about the theme: "Ang Marka ng Kabataang Makabansa".
6. The use of offensive, vulgar, and sexually explicit language and illustrations are not allowed.
7. The use of applications or art materials with ready-made illustrations and sketches are not allowed. Artworks lifted from the internet or owned by another artist would lead to the entry's immediate disqualification.
