## **GRANT OF SPECIAL ORDER FOR PRIVATE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS**

- To: Private School Senior High School Administrators All Others Concerned
  - 1. As per Regional Memorandum No. 013, s. 2020 on the Reiteration of Policy to Issuance of Special Order for Graduation, this Office informs all Private School Administrators in Senior High School that certain business processes shall be processed and acted on in the division offices and shall be forwarded to the regional office **fifteen (15) calendar days before the end of the academic year for the issuance of Special Order.**
  - 2. In view of this, SDO Bataan through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) – Private School Unit articulates the process, timeliness, and activities concerning to the issuance of Special Order for Graduation in private senior high schools. Private School Administrators are requested to prepare the following documentary requirements before its shall be acted upon by the Education Program Supervisor in charge in Private Schools, to wit:
    - A. List of Qualified Graduates (8.5x13)
      - 1. Per class/section/specialization
      - 2. Boys- 1<sup>st</sup> column, Numbered
      - 3. Girls- 2<sup>nd</sup> column, Numbered
      - 4. Maximum of 50 students per application
      - 5. Family Name, First Name, Middle Name
      - 6. Certified True and Correct by the School Head
    - B. Form 137 A (Permanent Record Secondary- Grades 7-10) (8.5x13)
    - C. Photocopy of PSA or NSO Birth Certificate
    - D. Form 137 A (Permanent Record SHS- Grades 11-12) (8.5x13)
       D.1. Full entry of Quarterly Grades and Final Grade for Grade 11, 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarte Grades for Grade 12
