**POSTPONEMENT OF CURRICULAR AND NON-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
DUE TO 2019-nCoV ARD**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Education Program Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
Heads, Public and Private Schools
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to the declaration of the World Health Organization (WHO) concerning the novel coronavirus acute respiratory disease (2019-nCoV ARD) health event as a public health emergency of international concern, and as stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No 15, s. 2020 "First Set of Policy Directives of the DepEd Task Force nCoV," this Office is likewise discouraging all schools to hold activities involving teaching, non-teaching and specially learners like film showing, school foundation day, JS Prom, Recollection, field trips, and other activities which require convergence of people.
2. Relative to this, schools are encouraged to conduct localized training program in preparation for the 2020 CLRAA and National Schools Press Conference respectively. School Heads and Public Schools District Supervisors are mandated to monitor the said localized training program to give technical assistance to make necessary interventions in the best possible way they can.
3. Likewise, final date on the resumption of CLRAA Quartering will be posted on DepEd Bataan site thru memorandum and other matters concerning the Intensive Training in preparation for 2020 CLRAA.
4. Private Schools are highly encouraged to follow the provisions in this Memorandum.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
