**NEW SCHEDULE OF SDO-BATAAN LOCALIZED TRAINING OF ATHLETES
AND CENTRAL LUZON REGIONAL ATHLETIC MEET 2020 (CLRAA)**

1. Pursuant to Division Memorandum No. 053, s. 2020, "Postponement of Curricular and Non-Curricular Activities due to 2019-nCoV ARD", this Office encourages schools to conduct localized training program on **February 10, 2020 – March 4, 2020** in preparation for the 2020 CLRAA Meet. Likewise, Intensive Training of athletes will resume on **March 5, 2020 up to March 19, 2020**.
2. As per Regional Memorandum No. 50, s. 2020 entitled "Postponement of the 2020 Central Luzon Regional Athletic Association (CLRAA) Meet" dated February 10, 2020, **CLRAA Meet was rescheduled to March 21-27, 2020** in the same venue **if** the suspension on national and regional activities involving learners and teachers is lifted on March 2020.
3. Public Schools District Supervisors and School In-Charge of Sports shall manage and monitor the training on their respective schools/districts and ensure that discipline is emphasized in as much as it is inherent in sports.
4. Key officials, coaches, chaperons and trainers must adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 entitled "DepEd Child Protection Policy". As such they will be held responsible for the protection, welfare, and safety of their pupil/student athletes.
5. Travel and other expenses incurred by the athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, chaperons, and trainers during the conduct of the localized training
