- 1. This Office encourages all Schools to strengthen and ensure the implementation of the Programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs) of the YES-O in pursuant with DepEd Order No. 72, s. 2003 entitled Establishment of the Youth for Environment for Schools (YFS) Organization and DepEd Order 93, s. 2011 entitled Mandated Programs, Projects and Activities, Various Forms, and Targets Pertinent to the Youth for Environment in Schools (YES) Program.
- 2. Youth for Environment in Schools(YES) Organization as a school-based co-curricular organization shall serve as a significant venue for students' actions and movements towards safeguarding, protecting and conserving the environment for future generations. Likewise, this shall also establish specific and doable programs, projects and activities to address issues and concerns on the environment and ecology.
- 3. The following programs, projects and activities may form part of the regular undertakings of the YES-O.

 - d. Symposia/ Training in the school level;
 - e. Tree-Planting Activities
 - f. Youth for Environment Camp
 - g. Other initiatives to support environmental and ecological movements in school.
- 4. For specific policy guidelines of the YES-O PPAs, kindly refer to DepEd Order No. 93, s. 2011 entitled Mandated Programs, Projects, and Activities, Various Forms, and Targets Pertinent to the Youth for Environment in Schools (YES) Program.

The Science Department Head/Coordinator/Teacher designated as School-Based YES-O Adviser shall lead and operationalize the YES activities in the school level with the guidance of the School Head/Principal.
