NON-SUSPENSION OF ELECTIONS OF SUPREME PUPIL/STUDENT GOVERNMENT

1. Pursuant to OUA unnumbered Memorandum, dated February 7, 2020, this Office announces that **the Supreme Pupil/Student Government (SPG/SSG) Synchronized Election on February 13, 2020 shall proceed** as specified in Division Memorandum No. 18, s. 2020, dated January 10, 2020.
2. However, as precautionary measure for the prevention and control of the 2019-NCOV ARD in basic education schools and offices, Presidential Election Forum, Campus-Wide Presidential and Vice Presidential Debates, and other activities that involve the gathering/ congregation of students and teachers are highly discouraged.
3. Candidates may conduct a room to room campaign but they must observe safety precautions and protocols as stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 015, s. 2020 entitled *First Set of Policy Directives of the DepEd Task Force NCOV*.
4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.
