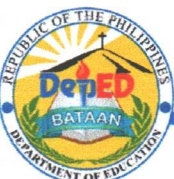

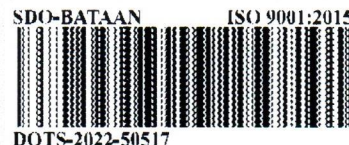

1. 
