Moreover, their comprehension skills accelerates as they read more books and other reading materials. Their level of understanding improves as they encounter more books.

Third, reading hones pupils' critical skills. As the learners become wide readers, their level of knowledge and understanding also reaches higher level. They start from literal then figurative then critical thinking. They learn to "read between the lines." They learn how to analyze, infer and conclude. They go beyond mere reading. They understand context and learn to make judgments according to what they undestand and read.

Fourth, reading improves the memory. The brain learns to function well. It also learns how to grasp details and ideas. It also helps the reader important facts and details.

Fifth, reading helps pupils become imaginative. By reading fiction, fantasies and other literature, the pupils' imagination is being stirred up and thus, it is developed. Reading stirs up imagination which in return, help them become creative.
