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Mechanics for the 2021 Regional ASEAN Contest

2021 ASEAN Chairmanship theme "We Care, We Prepare, We Prosper"

A. Spoken Word Poetry

- 1. Spoken Word Poetry is a performance art that is word based. It is meant to be spoken or recited with emotion to an audience. It is an oral art that focuses on the art of word play, rhythm, improvisation, intonation, and voice inflection.
- 2. Each Division Office shall select only one (1) JHS or SHS student for this coming School Year 2021-2022 to participate in this contest. The selection process of each Division is upon the discretion of each Division Office.
- 3. The spoken word poetry piece must be an original composition, written in Filipino or English but not in Taglish.
- 4. The piece must be anchored to this year's ASEAN Chairmanship theme "We Care, We Prepare, We Prosper" and must not contain any malicious and offensive content.
- 5. Sounds, instruments, or musical background is allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant opts not to have a musical background.
- 6. Each contestant must submit a PDF copy of the piece and a 3 to 4-minute recorded video of the delivery of the piece on or before 12 noon of September 08, 2021 at ginnojhep.pacquing@deped.gov.ph with this file name format (division_swp_title of swp) and the registration form.
- 7. Winners will receive a cash prize and certificate of recognition, consolation prize to the top five (5) participating entries (Php. 1,000.00) and all nonwinning entries will receive a certificate of participation.

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Criteria	Percentage
Message/Content The content of the spoken piece is relevant to the theme. The piece has a powerful and meaningful message to the audience.	40 %
Delivery and Performance The spoken piece is delivered from the heart. Facial expression, hand and body gestures that emphasize the different elements of the performance. Enunciation is clear. Audience can understand what is being spoken. Words are pronounced distinctly and correctly.	30 %
Originality The piece must be an original composition by the contestant.	20 %
Overall Impact The performer's physical appearance, voice and articulation, dramatic appropriateness, and evidence of understanding all seem on target and unified to breathe life into the piece.	10%
Total	100 %

8. The decision of the judges shall be final and irrevocable. Winners and awarding ceremony will be announced in a separate memorandum.

B. Digital Art Design

- 1. Digital Art Contest aims to showcase the best expressions of learners in digital art while highlighting the cultural uniqueness and identity shared by the whole ASEAN community.
- 2. Each Division Office shall select only one (1) JHS or SHS student for this coming School Year 2021-2022 to participate in this contest. The selection process of each Division is upon the discretion of each Division Office.
- 3. The digital art must be related to this year's ASEAN Chairmanship theme "We Care, We Prepare, We Prosper" and must not contain any malicious and offensive details.
- 4. Each contestant must submit the digital art design with the following details below on or before 12 noon of September 08, 2021 at ginnojhep.pacquing@deped.gov.ph with this file name format (division_dad_title of digital art design) and the registration form.





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- a. 5-7 sentences informative description of the art work (word format)
- b. The digital art work should be in PNG format transparent background.
- c. Resolution should be 300 dpi
- d. The digital art size should be 8.5 in (h) x 5.5 in (w).
- 5. Winners will receive a cash prize and certificate of recognition, consolation prize to the top five (5) participating entries (Php. 1,000.00) and all nonwinning entries will receive a certificate of participation.
