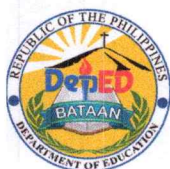

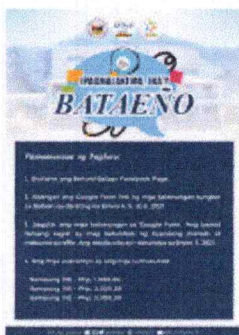

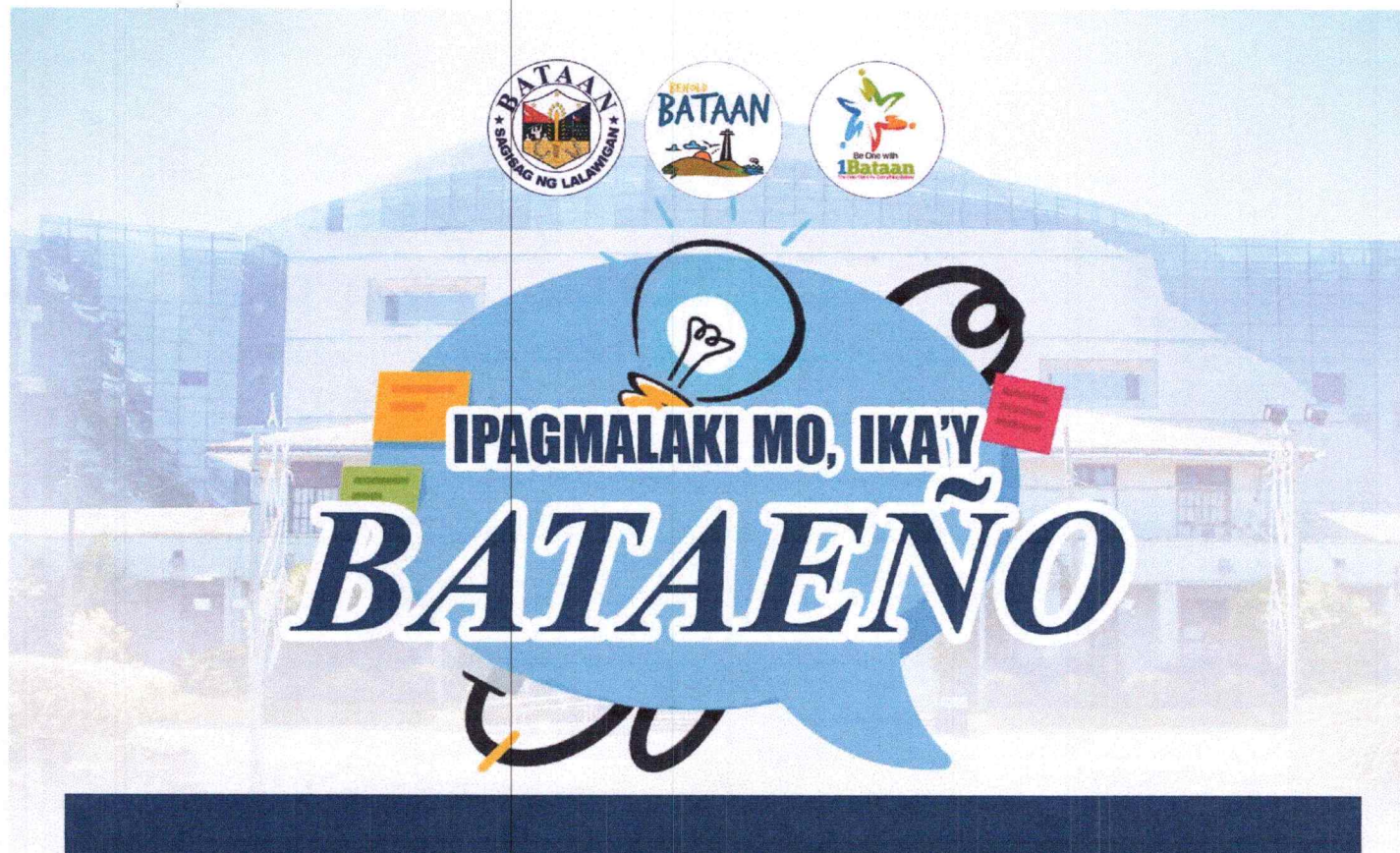

In connection thereto, may we request **students from Senior High School aged 18 years old** to be the participants for this cooking competition. Attached are the guidelines and mechanics for your reference.



MECHANICS FOR KULINARYA SA BATAAN

Mission

Kulinarya sa Bataan is a project of the Bataan Tourism Office with a mission to brand Bataan cuisine, recognize dishes of amateur cooks and food enthusiasts, and bring greater awareness and appreciation of cuisines making use of ingredients identified as Bataan's Best like Tinapa and Tuyo.

This event will showcase the cooking prowess and expertise of Junior and Senior High School cooks and foodies. We hope that through KSB, we could innovate dishes and create a new one with Bataan Identity.

Kulinarya sa Bataan will be held on 5 January 2020, 10 AM, at the Bataan Tourism Center. This event will kick off the celebration of Bataan Foundation Day 2020.

Partnership

The Provincial Tourism Office will partner with the City/Municipalities in the Province in this undertaking.

The KULINARYA SA BATAAN Mechanics:

The *Kulinarya sa Bataan* is organized to challenge the participants in making dishes with a twist, and the twist is to use Tinapa as main ingredient thus, will elevate the consciousness and appreciation of Bataan cuisine, and to further improve the quality of taste and presentation of Bataan dishes through a competition.

There will be a **maximum of twelve (12) contestants** who will compete for the Kulinarya sa Bataan.

(A) Eligibility

Contestants must be a **Junior or Senior High School** aged **18 years old** and must be endorsed by the City/Municipality they are representing as their official entry.

(B) General Rules and Guidelines

- 1.) The entrée recipe must use Tinapa as main ingredient.
- 2.) Contestants are required to provide/ submit a **short biography, the recipe and/or menu and a video presentation of the actual cooking of their entry dish and endorsement of their Municipal Mayor** by emailing these to tourism@bataan.gov.ph on or before 1pm, January 4, 2021.
- 3.) Each contestant must **bring their entry to the Bataan Tourism Center on 5 January 2021 at 10 AM.**
- 4.) **No cooking onsite** will be allowed during the competition proper. Entry dishes must be cooked **prior to arriving** at the venue.

- 5.) Each contestant must ensure that the entry dish that they will prepare and bring to the competition will be 5 individual servings carefully and neatly plated and packed in microwavable containers.
- 6.) To ensure fairness and objectivity, names of the contestants and the city/municipality they are representing **should not be revealed before and during the competition**. Number labels will be placed in each entry to aid the judges in voting for their **favourite dish**. The dishes with the most number of votes (1st, 2nd and 3rd) will be declared as Kulinarya sa Bataan Winner/Champion and two runners up.
- 7.) Procurement of recipe ingredients is the responsibility of the contestants.
- 8.) The contestant will provide table signage with name of dish and short description.
- 9.) Contestants are required to store their entry dishes in sealed containers to avoid contamination. Proper transportation procedures and standards should also be observed to avoid contamination and spoilage.
- 10.) Each contestant is responsible for setting up his display station and can leave after the set up.
- 11.) Contestants will be disqualified if they do not present their entrée in person at the designated time given by the *KSB Steering Committee*. No substitute and other assistance is allowed.
- 12.) Each contestant must comply with all food safety guidelines.
- 13.) By entering this competition, contestants grant permission to the Provincial Tourism Office to publish and/or use in any way the materials submitted, including the recipes and names and photos of competitors.
- 14.) The Provincial Tourism Office and KSB Steering Committee members shall not be liable or responsible for personal injury, or loss, or broken equipment and supplies brought by the contestants.
- 15.) The decision of the Judges over every instance shall be final and irrevocable and in their absolute discretion they may declare entry void should they consider it not reaching the required standards

(C) Awards and prizes for the Kulinarya sa Bataan

Following are the prizes at stake for winners of the competition:

First Prize	: Php 10,000.00
Second Prize	: Php 8,000.00
Third Prize	: Php 5,000.00
Consolation Prize	: Php 3,000.00

All contestants will receive a Certificate of Appreciation from the Provincial Tourism Office.
