

Contest Mechanics:

1. Each team must be composed of a minimum of 10 members to a maximum of 15 members. All members should be bona fide Grade 12 students of the school they are representing.
2. Participating teams can be composed on solely Grade 12 students, or a combination of Grade 11 and Grade 12 students, provided that there are more Grade 12 students than Grade 11 students.
3. Only one music shall be used by all competing teams. The official dance track will be exclusively provided by the Committee on Competition and shall be used during the actual day of the Inter-School Group Dance Competition. The team shall use the original dance track provided for their practice.
4. The official track will be provided upon registration. Only the first 15 schools to register will be included in the competition.
5. Registrations shall be done by filling out an online form. Interested schools may get the link to the form by contacting BHMC on 0921-2999-988 or 0927-878-8815.
6. Invited schools can register only one (1) team.
7. Lifting and pyramid stunts are not allowed. In case of violation, the team will be given a five (5) points deduction from the overall score (to be deducted by the committee.)
8. Competing teams are allowed to use appropriate costumes. Teams with costumes that are too revealing will not be allowed to compete.
9. For safety purposes, props and any other materials hazardous to the venue and event (such as fire, bladed weapons, ammunitions, etc.) are strictly not allowed.
10. Any lack or excess in the number of required members shall have an equivalent deduction of ten (10) point per person (to be deducted by the committee.)
11. The judging criteria shall be based on the following:

Criteria	Percentage
Costume and Presentation Appropriateness, originality, aesthetics, and effectiveness of costume to the dance routine	15%
Synchronization and Coordination Synchronization and "neatness" of the routine, as well as coordination during formations and transitions	30%
Creativity and Choreography Originality, pleasantness of transitions, flow of choreography, effectiveness of dance moves, complementariness to the beat of the music, use of different formations	30%
Overall Performance The general overall look, execution, attitude, crowd response, and energy of the group throughout the performance	25%
Total	100%

12. Prizes for the winning teams are as follows:

First Prize –	Php 20,000 cash prize, trophy, certificate of winning and participation
Second Prize –	Php 15,000 cash prize, trophy, certificate of winning and participation
Third Prize –	Php 10,000 cash prize, trophy, certificate of winning and participation
Consolation Prize -	Php 2,000 cash prize, certificate of participation
