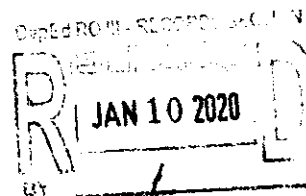

This particular session aims to analyze the 2020 National Budget and its impact on education sector. To shed light on some related issues, the TDC has invited subject-matter experts as resource speakers.


