FEEDBACK IN THE UTILIZATION OF THE BATAAN ONLINE LEARNING TABLET (BOLT)

- Bataan Online Learning Tablet (BOLT) is the Provincial Government of Bataan's
 project to empower public senior high school (SHS) learners in the Schools
 Division of Bataan (SDO Bataan) with mobile tablets to ensure that education
 continues despite the pandemic. With lessons uploaded in the mobile tablets,
 learners are able to access their lessons for the school year despite changes in
 the quarantine restrictions.
- 2. In this regard, recognizing the BOLT's essential usability, an online survey will be conducted to fully assess and evaluate the impact of the utilization of the mobile tablets distributed among public senior high school learners (grade 11 and grade 12).
- All SHS principals, assistant principals, teacher recipients, and teacher technical support group (ICT coordinators who configured the mobile tablets) are tasked to answer the survey form.
- Fifteen learner and fifteen parent participants will be randomly selected by District. Public Schools District Supervisors are requested to identify the number of participants per senior high school.
- 5. All participants to this survey are requested to access the link below appropriate to their identified set groups. School Heads shall coordinate the survey forms





among learners and parents. Submission of responses is on or before August 31, 2021.
