Budget Proposal on Online Division Training on Multiple Intelligences and Exploring New Thinking in Adapting our Teaching in the New Normal

I. Rationale:

As articulated in the Learning Continuity Plan (LCP), the Department of Education offers various learning modalities the schools and community learning centers as well as the parents can choose in facilitating the daily lessons. Teaching strategies or methodologies in the new normal which is appropriate to the chosen learning modalities, is then one of our utmost concerns. Integrating multiple intelligences in the new normal teaching strategies can possibly be one answer to this. One of the most significant results of the theory of multiple intelligences has provided eight different potential pathways to learning. If a teacher is having difficulty reaching a student in the more traditional linguistic or logical ways of instruction, the theory of multiple intelligences suggest several other ways in which the material might be presented to facilitate effective learning. Thus, Schools Division Office will conduct an Online Training on Multiple Intelligences and Exploring New Thinking in Adapting our Teaching in the New Normal.

II. Objectives:

Terminal Objectives:

1. To integrate various teaching strategies and methodologies appropriate to the context of learners in the new normal education and to incorporate visible thinking routine strategies in the new normal education.

2. To apply a range of new thinking models to develop critical and creative thinking, as well as higher order thinking skills adapted to the new normal.

Enabling Objectives:

- 1. To highlight learners' profile in the planning and delivery of instructions in the new normal;
- 2. To integrate Multiple Intelligences in teaching strategies in the new normal; and
- 3. To share ways forward on delivering quality education via integration of multiple intelligences.
- 4. To check on the reality of new normal education;
- 5. To determine what visible thinking routine strategies are in distance education; an
- 6. To reflect as a teacher of new normal education.
- 7. To apply specific strategies using whole brain thinking.
- 8. To introduce innovation as a design process and apply specific strategies employing design thinking
