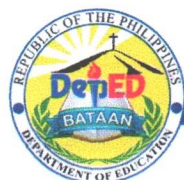
SCREENING OF SCIENCE INVESTIGATORY PROJECT PROPOSALS (SIP)

1. This Office informs all concerned that the Screening of Science Investigatory Projects (SIP) Proposals shall be conducted on November 16-17, 2022 at a venue to be announced later.
2. The Screening of Science Investigatory Project Proposals (SIP) serves as a venue for knowledge sharing, community engagement, and industry collaboration among students, teachers, industry partners, and science experts. The SIP activities include the four (4) major categories such as Life Science, Physical Science, Robotics & Intelligent Machines, and Mathematics & Computational Science.
3. The activity aims to:
 - a. empower the youth and cultivate innovation, creativity, and competence of the learners in addressing community problems for sustainable development and to maximize their potential to be inquisitive and creative in dealing with real-life problems, and
 - b. generate support fund from the partner agencies of the approved SIP proposals in the implementation of the Science Investigatory Projects.

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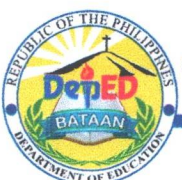
5. Each SIP research proponent/s shall present a maximum of 5-Minute PowerPoint Presentation showcasing their scientific research project proposals. The provisions of technical assistance shall proceed immediately after the presentation.
6. The project proposals will be screened according to the following criteria:

Originality and Innovation	25%
Technical and Scientific Merit	25%
Community Connection and Impact	25%
Excellence of Method	<u>25%</u>
Total	100%
7. The participation of teachers and students shall be subject to the no-disruption-of classes policy stipulated in DO No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the Policy on Off-campus Activities stated in DO No. 66, s. 2017.
8. Likewise, strict adherence to minimum health and safety protocols must be observed such as, but not limited to, the mandatory wearing of mask /face shield by all participants and members of the Technical Working Committee.
9. All expenses relative to the conduct of the Science Investigatory Projects can be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
