#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- All participants, coaches must be recommended, endorsed by their respective school heads/PSDS using the Registration Form in Enclosure no 4.
- All participants and coaches must follow the safety health protocols for this event.
- Coaches and trainers must secure parental consent from the parents of the contestant.
- Strictly follow the guidelines, mechanics, and criteria for judging.
- Send your entry on or before the specified date.

#### FOR ELEMENTARY LEVEL

### A. SPOKEN POETRY (Elementary Level Grades 4-6)

- The contestant should be bona fide public elementary students (Grades 4 –
- 6). There should only be one representative per district.
- For the elimination round, the participants will record his/her video of spoken poetry that is related to the theme and should not exceed three (3) minutes.
- The spoken poetry must be an original composition. It could be written in English or Filipino and must be delivered from memory with movements or gestures related to the piece. The piece shall have the following specifications:
  - Font size is 12

Mould Heroes

- Font type Tahoma
- One-inch margin on all sides
- Soft copies of the piece and the recorded video must be submitted on or before November 21, 2022, via Google Form to be posted in EsP Coordinators Group Chat. The date for submission will be strictly followed. Any entry submitted after the given date will be automatically disqualified.
- After the elimination round, five (5) contestants will be notified for the final round, which will be on November 28, 2022, at exactly 8:00 am where the **finalists will deliver their piece live via zoom**.
- Both the contestants and the coaches/trainers will receive certificates.

The contestant and coach/trainer will be held accountable for any issues

#### **B. SLOGAN MAKING CONTEST**

- The contest is open to public elementary students (Grade 4-6). There should only be one entry per District
- The Slogan must be original and must revolve around the theme. It should not be more than 16 words.

NOTE: The coach and the contestant will be held liable for copyright infringement or other issues that may arise regarding the authenticity of the slogan.

- The slogan should be written on one- fourth illustration board. No graphics, designs, or illustrations are allowed, only letters/words of the slogan will be written on the illustration board.
- All entries (3- minute video recording and the final output) must be submitted on or before November 21, 2022, via Google Form to be posted in EsP Coordinators Group Chat. The date for submission shall be strictly followed. Any entry submitted after the given date will be automatically disqualified.
- The following are the Criteria for Judging:

### C. LARAWAN NG PAGPAPAHALAGA (POSTER MAKING)

- The contestants should be bona fide public elementary students (Grades 4 6). There should only be one representative per district.
- The Poster must be original and must revolve around the theme.
- All entries must be submitted on or before November 21, 2022, via Google Form to be posted in EsP Coordinators Group Chat. The date for submission will be strictly followed. Any entry submitted after the given date will be automatically disqualified.
- Only the following materials will be allowed in the creation of the outputs:
  - a. 1/4 Illustration board
  - b. Pastel or crayons
  - c. Pencil and technical pen.
- For the transparency of the output, there should be a video of the contestant while making the poster from start to finish. The time limit for the video is three (3) minutes and the size should be limited to 1GB. Contestants / Coaches may edit and compress their videos using different software / applications to limit the size.
- Participants are also required to submit two (2) clear photos of the final output
   (1st photo close up shot, 2nd photo two-meter distance)

# FOR SECONDARY LEVEL A. SPOKEN POETRY

- The contest is open to bona fide public Junior High School students in all the public schools in Bataan.
- There should only be one (1) entry per Public Secondary School.
- The delivery should at least be for three (3) minutes but NOT to exceed five (5) minutes.
- The Spoken Poetry must be an original composition written/ delivered either in English or Filipino. The piece must be delivered from memory with movements or gestures related to the piece.
- The Spoken Poetry piece pre-judging video should go with the written piece following these specifications:
  - Font Size is 12
  - Font type is Times New Roman
  - One-inch margin on all sides
- Each participating public Secondary School should submit a copy of the video of the Spoken Poetry and the written piece on/or before November 21, 2022, for the Pre-Judging Phase via Google Form to be posted in EsP Coordinators Group Chat.
- There will be five (5) qualifiers who will be chosen from the Pre-Judging Phase and each of the Top 5 will present their Spoken Poetry during the online program via Zoom on <u>November 29, 2022 at 8:00 am.</u>
- Three (3) winners will be declared based on their actual online performance.
- Winners will receive medals and certificates.
- The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
- The following are the Criteria for Judging:

Content/Substance/Originality 40%
Delivery/Performance 30%
Originality 20%
Online Stage Presence 10%
TOTAL 100%

#### **B. E-SLOGAN MAKING CONTEST**

- This contest is open to all public Junior High School students. There should be only ONE entry per school.
- The Slogan must be ORIGINAL and could be written in English or Filipino.
   NOTE: The coach and the contestant will be held liable for copyright infringement or other issues that may arise regarding the authenticity of the slogan.
- The slogan must effectively interpret the theme. It should not be more than 16 words.
- The size of the paper for the slogan should be 9 inches x 12 inches (size of Oslo paper).
- No graphics or illustrations are allowed, only letters/words of the slogan.
- All entries (3- minute video recording and the final output) must be submitted on or before November 21, 2022, via Google Form to be posted in EsP Coordinators Group Chat.
- The use of any digital app preferred by the participant is allowed.
- The following are the Criteria for Judging:

Relevance to the Theme 40%
Originality 30%
Creativity 20%
Neatness and Layout 10%
TOTAL 100%

# C. LARAWAN NG PAGPAPAHALAGA (POSTER MAKING)

- The contestant should be bona fide Junior High School student (Grades 7-10). There should only be one representative per school.
- The Poster must be original and must revolve around the theme.
- All entries must be submitted on or before November 21, 2022, via Google Form to be posted in EsP Coordinators Group Chat. The date for submission will be strictly followed. Any entry submitted after the given date will be automatically disqualified.

- Only the following materials will be allowed in the creation of the outputs:
  - a. 1/4 Illustration board
  - b. Pastel or crayons
  - c. Pencil and technical pen.
- For the transparency of the output, there should be a video of the contestant while making the poster from start to finish. The time limit for the video is three (3) minutes and the size should be limited to 1GB. Contestants / Coaches may edit and compress their videos using different software / applications to limit the size.
- Participants are also required to submit two (2) clear photos of the final output (1<sup>st</sup> photo – close up shot, 2<sup>nd</sup> photo – two-meter distance)
- Both contestants and coaches/trainers will receive certificates.
- The contestant and coach/trainer will be held accountable for any issues that may arise regarding the originality and authenticity of the output.
- The decision of judges is final and irrevocable.
- The following are the Criteria for Judging:

Creativity	25%
Originality	20%
Relevance to the Theme	35%

### D. VALUE/VIRTUE EXPOSITION

- This contest is open to public bona fide Senior High School students. There should only be only one representative from each Senior High School.
- The Value/Virtue Exposition is an impromptu discussion / presentation of values/virtues taken from the value clusters for ethical themes and DepEd Core Values.
- The presentation/discussion will focus on the content of value/virtue, its relevance, and its application to the life of the student and the community in general.

- The Filipino language will be used as a medium in the presentation (discussion of values/virtues)
- There will be an elimination round and a final round.
- Elimination round: Each contestant may choose one value/virtue from the value clusters and DepEd core values to deliver/present for the pre- judging phase. The presentation should only be 2-3 minutes.
- Each participating public Secondary School should submit a copy of the video of the actual delivery of the student on/or before November 29, 2022, for the pre-judging phase via Google Form to be posted in EsP Coordinators Group Chat.
- Final round: The top five contestants who will qualify for this round will be notified. They will present one common value/virtue via an online platform with
  - only the judges and trainer as an audience. The Judges will draw on the actual day what value/virtue will be delivered by the finalist.
- The contestant will be given five (3) minutes to prepare and three (3) minutes to present.
- The decision of the judges shall be final and non-appealable.
- The following are the Criteria for Judging:

Content and Relevance	50%
Organization of Idea	20%
Delivery	20%
Over-All Impact	10%
