

#### FIRST CALL FOR CY 2023 SEAMEO INNOTECH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. Consistent with the goal of the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) to provide Professional Development Programs that will upskill and reskill the teachers and school leaders, this Office informs the Schools Division Offices about the First Call of the Scholarship Programs offered by the Southéast Asian Minister of Education, Organization, Innovation, and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) for Calendar Year 2023.
- 2. SEAMEO INNOTECH offers four (4) Flexible Learning Courses (FLCs) titled: Strategic Thinking and Innovation Course 1 (Essentials of Strategic Thinking and Innovation); Strategic Thinking and Innovation Course 2 (Charting an Innovative School Strategy; Strategic Thinking and Innovation Course 3 (Leading and Sustaining Change); and Early Literacy for K3 Teachers. It also offers two (2) Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) titled Teach On: Keeping the Passion Alive and Becoming a Better Teacher Everyday.
- 3. Course details, target participants, program descriptions, timeline, assessment requirements, certificate, equivalent training hours, and value can be seen in *Enclosure 1* (Accredited SEAMEO INNOTECH Course Details), as reference of the SDOs in choosing the best applicants for the courses.
- 4. To facilitate the filling of slots, interested teachers and school leaders shall inform the SDO's Senior Education Program Specialists/Education Program Specialists II of HRD to secure their slots. Details needed in the accomplishment of the Google Spreadsheet link include the participant's name, school, position, active cellphone number, DepEd email address, and their Facebook URL. The application period for these courses will be open until **January 20, 2023.** The registration link can be accessed thru: <a href="mailto:bit.ly/SEAMEO-R3-2023">bit.ly/SEAMEO-R3-2023</a>. All the names and information encoded until the said deadline will be formally endorsed to the SEAMEO INNOTECH as participants for the First Call of the scholarship programs. After the deadline, unfilled slots per SDO will reopen for the Second Call until such time that all the slots are occupied.







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- 5. An orientation among those who signified their intent to participate in these NEAP-recognized professional development programs will be conducted at the end of January. Contracts are expected to be accomplished and signed by the interested participants along with their direct supervisor. The sample of the contract is in Enclosure 2 while the soft copy of the contract can be accessed in the link below. The participants are requested to upload the scanned and signed copy of their contracts in this link: https://tinyurl.com/SEAMEOContracts-R3.
- 6. Registration fees will be paid by the NEAP Central Office. MOOCs are worth 500 pesos per learner while FLCs ranges from 7,500 15,000 pesos per learner. In case of withdrawals and/or incompletion, the same amount will be refunded by the Central Office from the participants themselves.

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- submit to the head of office and the Department of Education (DepEd) through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) a copy of the NEAP-PDP Action Plan containing lessons for the conduct of echo seminars to share new learnings, teaching innovations, and strategies to their co-workers and administrators, various trainings, program highlights and general impressions constituting a general evaluation of the program at the end of the program or course;
- d. implement the echo seminars / LAC Sessions and submit reports to the QUALITY ASSURANCE DIVISION, National Educators Academy of the Philippines at Second Floor, Mabini Building, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City;
- e. teach the subject / conduct echo seminars / LAC Sessions on the course in which they participation in continue to serve their school / division / region for at least three years which is the service obligation equivalent for a year of scholarship or a fraction thereof;
- fulfill the service obligation as required under Sections 17 and 19 Rule VIII of the Omnibus Rules Implementing Book V of Executive Order No. 292;
- refund in full to DepEd such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government for expenses incidental for having attended the program or course, for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions through my fault or willful neglect, resignation from the service, transfer to other agencies, voluntary retirement or other causes within my control. For reasons beyond the control of the teacher-participant, the conditions do not apply, provided that all documentary requirements including doctor's certification are met and are acceptable to DepEd.
