Nonetheless, schools can protect students with certain medical requirements from risks like bullying. Before responding to bullying, instructors should treat the medical issue if a kid with health requirements experiences a medical reaction. Teaching kids about their unique health requirements as well as the dangers of exposures and activities can help keep them safe. Lots of physical and cognitive energy for some children to overcome the challenges posed by their difficulties/ disabilities, thus, positive motivation and encouragement are needed to make each child develop a positive attitude toward school and learning. It takes a big heart for a teacher to handle SPED learners.

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
