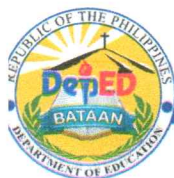

**ADMINISTRATION OF POST TEST USING THE ASSESSMENT TOOLS FOR
PROJECT ALL NUMERATES (PAN) FOR GRADES 1 - 7 LEARNERS**

1. This Office announces the Administration of Post-Test using the Assessment Tools for Project All Numerates for Grades 1-7 learners in all public schools in the division of Bataan on May 15-19, 2023 as stated in the Regional Memorandum No. 137, s. 2023.
2. The objectives of the test are:
 - a. Determine the numeracy level of Grades 1-7 learners;
 - b. Recommend the best method in administering the post-test of the project all numerates; and
 - c. Use the results as a springboard for research and policy recommendations for the improvement of the instruction and performance of Grades 1-7 learners in Mathematics.
3. The administration of the PAN Post-test shall be scheduled during the Mathematics classes from May 15 - 19, 2023 to be monitored by the school heads.
4. School heads shall supervise the consolidation of PAN post test results and analysis using the template in Enclosure No 1 and assign the Mathematics Coordinator to encode the summary of result to google sheet in the google drive by the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) on or before May 23, 2023. A repository google drive will be provided by the Education Program Supervisor to be forwarded to Mathematics district coordinators and Departments Heads on or before the test administration.
5. As technical assistance to all G1- G7 Math teachers and Math Coordinators, a PAN School Consolidated Results Generator Tool shall be provided by the EPS. Relative to this, there will be an online meeting of Mathematics District Coordinators, Department Heads and the Division EPS-Math on

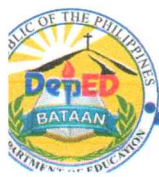

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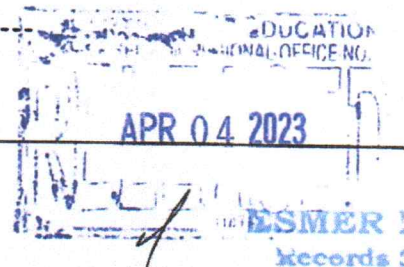
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

PROJECT ALL NUMERATES FOR GRADES 1-7 LEARNERS**

1. The assessment tools for Project All Numerates in Mathematics for Grades 1- 7 are now ready for post-test administration in all public schools in Region III which is scheduled on **May 15-19, 2023**.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. determine the numeracy level of Grades 1-7 learners;
 - b. recommend the best method in administering the post-test of the project all numerates; and
 - c. use the results as a springboard for research and policy recommendations for the improvement of the instruction and performance of Grade 1-7 learners in Mathematics.
3. In this regard, the Regional and Division Math Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) shall supervise, monitor, and evaluate the conduct of the post-test to provide technical assistance and recommend solutions to the identified gaps and problems that may arise during the implementation.
4. The Division Math EPSs shall determine the number of numerates, nearly numerate, and non-numerates in their respective divisions together with the mean percentage scores, the number of enrollees per school and per grade level, the number of test takers, and the top 5 most mastered and least learned competencies.
5. The Division Math EPSs and School Principals shall coordinate with their Division LR Supervisors regarding the assessment tools and the key answers that will be downloaded for reproduction.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is hereby enjoined.
