

# CELEBRATION OF THE 125TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PROCLAMATION OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE

Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents Heads of Public Schools and Learning Centers All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 030, s. 2023 dated May 17, 2023, DepEd will participate in the commemoration of the 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence from May 28 to June 30, 2023, with the theme *Kalayaan, Kinabukasan, Kasanayan*.
- 2. Accordingly, the following activities shall be implemented in the Region:
  - Simultaneous Flag Raising in schools or historical sites on June 12, 2023;
  - b. Display of the Philippine Flag in the classroom and residences of all teaching and nonteaching personnel from May 15 to June 30, 2023;
  - c. Discussion on the Philippine flag awareness and significant events in history, which led to the Proclamation of Philippine Independence especially in Sibika at Kultura, Heograpiya, Kasanayan (HEKASI), Araling Panlipunan, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP), Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH), Filipino and English, at least once a week for the whole year;
  - d. Submission of school work related to the celebration of Independence Day. Grades 1 to 3 learners will submit a drawing of the Philippine Flag, while higher grade levels will submit a one-page reflection paper on what they did during Independence Day or share experiences on what the Philippine Independence means to them, to be collected by their teachers;
  - e. Conduct of symposium and/or round table discussion to raise awareness on the event, and propagate values like nationalism, patriotism, and love of country, which were exhibited by the Filipinos during the trying periods of the country;
  - Putting up a bulletin board or a venue within the campus where informative materials concerning the commemorative event may be displayed;

- g. A month-long sharing of insights on the same topic is encouraged during the flag ceremony at the RO, SDOs and schools to be spearheaded by the Araling Panlipunan Supervisors; and
- h. Other creative and fitting activities.
- 3. Additionally, there shall be a Simultaneous Flag Raising and Wreath-Laying Ceremonies on June 12, 2023, 7:00 a.m. at the Barasaoin Church Historical Landmark, Malolos City, Bulacan and Museum of Philippine Social History, Angeles City, Pampanga.
- 4. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) of Malolos City and Angeles City shall send at least 100 teachers and nonteaching personnel to attend the simultaneous flag raising and wreath-laying ceremonies. The concerned Schools Division Superintendents shall assign their Focal Person who shall coordinate with their respective Local Government Unit (LGU) to ensure the smooth implementation of the activities.
- 5. All DepEd officials, teachers and learners at the regional, schools division and schools levels are required to actively participate in the scheduled activities.
- 6. Teachers shall receive appropriate service credits as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 053, s. 2003 and DepEd Order No. 084, s. 2003, while nonteaching personnel who will attend the simultaneous flag-raising ceremonies shall be entitled to a Compensatory Time-Off.
- 7. Expenses relative to the implementation of various activities, like the purchase of flags, flaglets, informative materials, traveling and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the MOOE of the concerned RO, SDOs and schools.
- 8. Widest dissemination, and compliance of this Memorandum is desired.

#### 125th anniversary of the proclamation of Philippine independence

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd) will participate in the commemoration of the 125th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence with the theme, Kalayaan. Kinabukasan. Kasaysayan from May 28 to June 30, 2023. This is in accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 110, s. 1963, titled Declaring June 12 as Philippine Independence Day, and Administrative Order No. 23, s. 2011, titled Creating a Steering Committee on National Observances. All departments, bureaus, offices, government agencies, and government-owned and controlled corporations are required to give full support, assistance, and cooperation to the National Steering Committee (NSC), chaired by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), in the exercise of its responsibilities and functions in order to achieve the celebration's objectives.
- 2. This year's celebration aims to
  - commemorate the heroism, patriotism, nationalism, and self-sacrifice of our Filipino forefathers in the struggle for independence;
  - instill in the hearts and minds of the youth the greatness of the Filipino race, the legacy of their national heroes, and the ideals of their nationhood; and
  - c. show unity and strength during challenging times.
- 3. The exhibit on Pampamahalaang Programa at Serbisyo, an activity that will showcase the programs and services of various government offices, will be held on **June 11-12**, **2023** (Sunday and Monday), from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Rizal Park, Roxas Boulevard, Manila. The following DepEd offices are invited to participate:
  - a. Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA),
  - b. Public Affairs Service (PAS),
  - Administrative Service (General Services Division),
  - d. External Partnerships Service-Special Events Unit (EPS-SEU)-National Technical Working Group (TWG/Coordinator), and
  - e. DepEd National Capital Region (NCR).
- 4. To commemorate the 125th Anniversary of Philippine Independence and to observe the National Flag Day, the DepEd central office (CO), regional offices (RO), schools division offices (SDO), and schools are required to undertake the following activities:

- a. Simultaneous Flag Raising in schools or historical sites on June 12, 2023;
- Display of the Philippine Flag in the classrooms (charged to the School's MOOE), offices, and residences of all teaching and nonteaching personnel from May 15 to June 30, 2023;
- c. Discussions on the Philippine flag awareness and significant events in history, which led to the Proclamation of Philippine Independence especially in Sibika at Kultura, Heograpiya, Kasaysayan at Sining (HEKASI), Araling Panlipunan, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP), Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH), Filipino and English, at least once a week for the whole year;
- d. Submission of school work related to the celebration of Independence Day. Grades 1 to 3 learners will submit a drawing of the Philippine Flag, while higher grade levels will submit a one-page reflection paper on what they did during Independence Day or share experiences on what the Philippine Independence means to them, to be collected by their teachers;
- e. Conduct of symposium and/or round table discussion to raise awareness on the event, and propagate values like nationalism, patriotism, and love of country, which were exhibited by the Filipinos during the trying periods of the country;
- f. Putting up a bulletin board or a venue within the campus where informative materials concerning the commemorative event may be displayed;
- g. A month-long sharing of insights on the same topic is encouraged during the flag ceremony at the ROs, SDOs, and schools to be spearheaded by the Araling Panlipunan Supervisors; and
- h. Other creative and fitting activities.
- 5. All DepEd officials, teachers, and learners at the national, regional, schools division, and school levels are required to actively participate in the scheduled activities.
- 6. DepEd requests the support, assistance, and cooperation of the regions stated in the enclosure for the Simultaneous Flag Raising and Wreath-laying Ceremonies on **June 12, 2023, 8:00 a.m.** at various historical sites and venues.
- 7. Teachers shall receive appropriate service credits as stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 53, s. 2003, titled **Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers**, and DO 84, s. 2003, titled **Addendum to DO No. 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers)**, while nonteaching personnel should attend programs and activities on **official time only**.
- 8. Travel expenses (transportation and per diem) of the TWG, meals, communication, documentation, supplies, carpentry materials, preparatory, and other incidental expenses from May 28 to June 30, 2023, shall be charged to the 2023 Building Partnership and Linkages Program, whereas exhibitors' travel expenses from various DepEd offices and participating schools, and the materials production of flyers, tarpaulins, and other materials shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
