To support the participants during their stay, the DAP will sponsor accommodation and meals for the duration of the event. Winning participants will receive special prizes.



FLOW OF HEART AND MIND

MECHANICS

1. Theme: The theme of the on-the-spot painting competition is "Kapwa: Retracing the Nation Builders Flow of Heart and Mind." Participants are required to create an artwork on the spot that explores and expresses the concept of "Kapwa" and the role of nation builders in the development and unity of the Filipino people.

2.Eligibility: The competition is open to all artists, both amateur and mentors of the participating school of the Senior High School and College Category, who are residents of the Philippines.

3.Materials: Participants are required to bring their own painting materials, including brushes, paints (watercolor, acrylic, or oil), canvas or paper, and any additional materials they may need for their artwork. The use of digital tools or photography is not allowed for this competition.

MECHANICS

4.Time Limit: The set time for the competition will start from 1:00 pm of first day and participants must complete their artwork by 1:00 pm of the second day.

5.Artwork Size: Participants should create their artwork on a canvas or paper of standard size, 24x36 inches.

7. Judging Panel: A panel of judges consisting of art experts, curators, and professionals in the field will evaluate the artworks based on the above criteria.
