- This Office hereby disseminates Regional Memorandum No. 400, s. 2023, dated August 2, 2023, titled "GRANT OF AN AUTOMATIC TWO-MONTH MORATORIUM ON PAYMENT OF PROVIDENT FUND LOAN OF BORROWERS AFFECTED BY CALAMITY".
- 2. In the case of the Province of Bataan, which was officially declared under the state of calamity, on July 29, 2023, per RESOLUTION NO. 321 due to the effects of Southwest Monsoon (Habagat) enhanced by Typhoon "EGAY" (DOKSURI), a two-month moratorium shall apply to all PF Borrowers affected covering September to October 2023 payroll with no additional interest imposed on their loans.

#### REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No. 400, s. 2023

GRANT OF AN AUTOMATIC TWO-MONTH MORATORIUM ON PAYMENT OF PROVIDENT FUND LOAN OF BORROWERS AFFECTED BY CALAMITY

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents All Others Concerned

- 1. The MEMORANDUM OUF-2023-0494, dated July 11, 2023, was issued by the Department of Education (DepEd) Provident Fund National Board of Trustees (PFNBT) implementing Provident Fund (PF) Resolution No. 5 entitled "A Resolution Approving the Grant of an Automatic Two-Month Moratorium on Payment of PF Loan Amortizations of Borrowers Affected by Calamity".
- 2. In the case of the Province of Pampanga, which was officially declared on July 31, 2023, under the state of calamity per RESOLUTION NO. 8058 due to the effects of Southwest Monsoon enhanced by Tropical Cyclones "Egay and Falcon", a two-month moratorium shall apply to all PF borrowers affected covering August to September 2023 payroll with no additional interest imposed on their loans.
- The PF borrowers from the rest of the provinces, municipalities, and barangays in the region under the state of calamity shall, likewise, have a twomonth moratorium on their loans.
- 4. The DepEd Payroll Units are directed to implement the loan moratorium and PF Chapters shall report to the PF Regional Board of Trustees, through the Regional Board Secretariat, who in turn shall consolidate and report to the PFNBT, through the National Board Secretariat, within the first week of its implementation and two weeks after the end of the grant of the same and inform the borrowers, accordingly.
- 5. Copies of the said memorandum including Annex A are attached for reference.
- Immediate and widest dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

- 1. This is to inform you of the approval of Provident Fund (PF) Board Resolution No. 05, s. 2023, entitled "A Resolution Approving the Grant of an Automatic Two-Month Moratorium on Payment of Provident Fund Loan (PF) Amortizations of Borrowers Affected by Calamity" by the DepEd PF National Board of Trustees (PFNBT).
- 2. Pursuant to said PF Board Resolution, the following are the guidelines in granting the automatic two (2)-month moratorium:
  - a. There is a declaration of state of calamity officially issued by either the President of the Philippines, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and its counterpart agencies in the Regions, Provinces. Cities and Municipalities, or by the Legislative Councils of Local Government Units concerned:
  - b. The 2-month moratorium SHALL APPLY TO ALL PF BORROWERS who are teaching and non-teaching personnel and actually working and/or residing in regions/s, province/s, city/ies or schools division/s covered by the declaration of a state of calamity;
  - c. Existing PF deductions to be temporarily stopped shall be lodged at the "Undeducted Obligations" of the payslips of the borrower, and shall automatically be restored to the payroll after the 2-month period is implemented;
  - d. Loan term in the payroll program shall be adjusted/extended corresponding to the 2 month of loan moratorium:

- e. No additional interest shall be imposed on the loan accounts during the moratorium period:
- f. The Loan moratorium shall take effect immediately in the next payroll month after the declaration of the state of calamity;
- g. All payroll units in the region/schools division/implementing unit-secondary schools shall be directed to implement the loan moratorium:
- h. All PF Chapters are directed to reposition loan moratorium granted to PF borrowers not later than two words after the end of the grant of loan moratorium; and
- i. All PF Chapters, through their respective Board Chairperson, shall submit a report to the PFNBT, through the PFNBT valional Board Secretariat (PFNBS), on the availment of the loan moratorium as soon as the same has been effected by the Payroll Units concerned (Aprica A attached for the template), within first week of its implementation of the loan moratorium.
