After all these numerous screenings and requirements submitted, the most outstanding teacher with the highest points will be awarded.

To be awarded as the Dakilang Guro is both a prestigious honor and a worthwhile achievement, as it mirrors your efforts and dedication to your profession. However, not everyone dares to achieve this award. Not everyone gives their best to be named a "Dakilang Guro".
