Greetings!

The Philippine Statistics Authority-Bataan is committed to register 119,979 residents in Bataan for Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) by the end of December 2023. As of 31 August 2023, the PSA-Bataan has registered 25,934 Bataños to the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) and issued 153,372 ePhilIDs.

Given that the majority of the remaining unregistered individuals are children aged 5 to 15 years old, all PSA Field Offices are instructed to conduct School Registration Campaign.

In line with this, may we request your good office to support this undertaking by allowing us to conduct a school registration campaign.

The School Registration Campaign is a strategy that addresses the low registration turnout during school registration due to a lack of awareness of students and parents on the required supporting documents for PhilSys registration and its benefits for children. This strategy also aims to increase the number of schools that support the conduct of PhilSys School Registration Campaign and effectively cascade pertinent information to teachers, parents, and students through the conduct of school/class briefings/orientations and provision of information, education, and communication materials.
