**TRAINING WORKSHOP ON THE STRENGTHENING OF
CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEE (CPC) AND
LEARNERS' RIGHT AND PROTECTION (LRP)

1. The Schools Division Office of Bataan informs the field on the conduct of hybrid **Training Workshop on the Strengthening of Child Protection Committee (CPC) and Learners' Rights and Protection (LRP) in Schools** on **September 28-29, 2023**.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. ensure the establishment and functionality of the CPC to protect and keep the learners safe from abuse, violence, exploitation, bullying and all forms of abuse;
 - b. guide CPC in planning, implementing, and promoting advocacy programs, projects, and consultation which primarily seek the perspective of learners as the main concern of the Child Protection Policy; and
 - c. spread awareness on the best interest of the child and their right to be heard.
3. In this connection, Elementary District Coordinators on LRP (PSDS), select Guidance Counselors/Teachers and Parent-Teachers Association (PTA) members, Division Federated Supreme Elementary and Secondary Learners Government Officers, Provincial Council for the Protection of Children (PCPC) members, and Private School Administrators/Guidance Counselors are required to attend the face-to-face activity on the first day at Pan Resort and Hotel, Abucay, Bataan. Further, all public School Principals are required to attend the second day of the said activity via virtual platform (See Enclosure).

4. Link for the virtual activity on the second day will be sent through the Public School District Supervisors to be disseminated to the participants ahead of time.
5. In addition, there will be a registration fee of **Php 800.00** to be charged from each participant from private schools to cover expenses of their meals and venue.
6. Further, for participants from public schools, all expenses relative to the conduct of the said activity shall be charged against school MOOE/local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. This Memorandum shall serve as the travel authority of the participants.
8. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
