# Child Protection Committee (CPC) Database for School Year 2023-2024

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 titled: DepEd Child Protection Policy, states in Section 10. Establishment of Child Protection Committee mandates that all Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools shall establish a Child Protection Committee (CPC). This Office through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) facilitates the consolidation of the "Child Protection Committee (CPC) Database for School Year 2023-2024" to be accomplished on November 10, 2023.

- 4. The CPC shall perform the following functions:
  - a. Draft a school child protection policy with a code of conduct and a plan to ensure child protection and safety, which shall be reviewed every three (3) years;

- b. Initiate information dissemination programs and organize activities for the protection of children from abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination, and bullying or peer abuse;
- c. Develop and implement a school-based referral and monitoring system;
- d. Establish a system for identifying students who may be suffering from significant harm based on any physical, emotional, or behavioral signs;
- e. Identify, refer, and if appropriate, report to the appropriate offices those cases involving child abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination, and bullying;
- f. Assist parents or guardians, whenever necessary in securing expert guidance counseling from appropriate offices or institutions;
- g. Coordinate closely with Women and Child Protection Desks of the Philippine National Police (PNP), the Local Social Welfare and Development Offices Non-Governmental (LSWDO), other government agencies, and Organizations (NGOs), as may be appropriate;
- h. Monitor the implementation of positive measures and effective procedures in providing the necessary support for the child and for those who care for the child: and
- i. Ensure that the children's right to be heard are respected and upheld in all matters and procedures affecting their welfare.
