



- 3. Qualifications for Participation. The following are the minimum qualifications for participating Rovers, Rover Leaders, and RST, viz:

#### a. Rover Scouts

- Must be currently registered with a Rover Circle in good standing
- Must be at least sixteen (16) to twenty-six (26) years old; and those are in the Senior High School in the Rover Scouting Section
- Must have a Health and Medical Certificate to be Physically Fit as certified by a Licensed Physician
- · Must have a Parent's Permit for participants below 18 years old
- Must have a complete set of camping gear and equipment
