As a positive response and continuous support to this Department's priority project, SDO-Bataan through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) Learning Resources Management and Development Section (LRMDS) spearheaded the establishment of **School Knowledge Hubs** in all public elementary and secondary schools in the Division.
- 3. The **School Knowledge Hub** encompasses the various areas within the school that house learning resources, promote reading, and support student academic endeavors. It signifies a central hub of knowledge and information within the school, where students can access a wide range of resources and engage in learning activities. The term "School Knowledge Hub" emphasizes the importance of both learning and reading, while encompassing the different types of learning spaces including the Library, Learning Resource Center, Reading Center, Reading Corner, and Reading Kiosk.
- 4. In line with this, this Office announces the conduct of the 2023 Division Search for the Best School Knowledge Hub Implementers to be awarded in the Annual Gawad PANTAS this December 2023.

- 9. Meals and snacks, supplies/materials, and other expenses relative to this activity can be charged to the School MOOE and/or other available funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

# GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS TO THE DIVISION SEARCH FOR THE 2023 BEST SCHOOL KNOWLEDGE HUB (SKH) IMPLEMENTERS

#### I. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:

Under Regional Memorandum No. 159 s. 2023 – Dissemination of the Letter of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Teaching on Reiterating the "Institutionalization of DepEd Library Hub Project in all Regions and Schools Divisions Nationwide", and as part of the MATATAG Agenda in improving the quality of basic education for Filipino learners, DepEd Central Office requests the commitment of all Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents, and School Heads in putting-up similar infrastructure that makes reading and learning materials available for all learners

- 2. The categories for the Best School Knowledge Hub Implementers are:

  - b. Most Functional School Learning Resource Center
  - c. Most Functional School Reading Center
  - d. Most Functional Reading Corner
  - e. Most Functional Reading Kiosk



















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- 3. All Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) in coordination with the District LRMDS Coordinators shall lead the conduct of the initial evaluation and submit ONLY ONE (1) official entry for each category (either elementary, junior, or senior high school) on or before November 17, 2023, to the LRMDS Office.
- 4. Nonetheless, it is deemed permissible if the nominated school within the district meets the qualifications and is endorsed by the District Search Committee for one or multiple categories.
- 5. The Division Learning Resource Management and Development Section Staff will conduct unannounced monitoring and evaluation of each nominated School Knowledge Hub between November 13 and 24, 2023, using the provided rubric and monitoring tool.
- 6. The nominated school achieving the highest score in each category will be recognized as the Most Functional School Knowledge Hub and honored at the Annual Gawad PANTAS in December 2023.
