

In order to spread a culture of peace, the peace education materials will serve as a permanent symbol that will remind the peace-loving Peace Education constituents of BARMM of the shared responsibility to make the school a zone of peace. The Schools Division of Cotabato City is an ambassador of peace that believes in the role and duty of faculty members and students as peacemakers who protect each other from violent conflicts by creating a progressive and peaceful campus through HWPL's three core peace initiatives especially Peace Education.

Therefore, the National Peace Education Convention to be held in Mindanao seeks to highlight the importance of peace education, share best practices, and generate innovative approaches to promote peace and reconciliation in the region, as SDO Cotabato City as the Pilot Implementer.
