Greetings of peace!

The Senior High Network is a loose network of individuals and organizations advocating for a more responsive, engaging, and relevant implementation of senior high school program in the country. The network tasked itself with initiating forums, discussions, workshops, and other forms of advocacy. It has also reached out to friendly institutions to work together on advocacy and future projects.

The Network will have its initial forum coinciding with its formal launch on January 20, 2024, Saturday from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. at the HRD Auditorium of the Philippine Normal University (PNU) in Taft Avenue, Manila. With the theme Teachers and Students for Transformative SHS the forum shall focus on two main topics: the calls to restore Philippine History as a dedicated subject in high school and the discussion of the United Nations (UN) Tax Convention. 


