Reiteration of Fire Safety Measures for DepEd Offices and Schools

Fire Safety Measures for Offices and Schools

1. Formulate a FIRE ESCAPE PLAN.
2. Ensure the presence of FIRE ESCAPE ROUTES and EXIT PATHS which the personnel and learners should be aware of. These should be clearly marked with readable SIGNAGE.
3. Inspect doors and windows of buildings and ensure that they are easy to open.
4. Ensure that exit/escape paths are free of obstruction.
5. Trim shrubs and trees in the vicinity.
6. Enforce proper waste management. Clear the offices and school grounds from waste. Combustible waste such as papers, wood plastics, paint tins, flammable liquids should not be stored in heaps or loose in the open. Suitable receptacles such as litter bins, recycling bins, etc. should be provided.
7. Conduct regular electrical safety inspection and take necessary actions to repair or replace defective wirings, light bulbs, etc. and disconnect the electrical wirings on a condemned building.
8. Demand and practice good office and school keeping practices, e.g. inspect laboratories daily; unplug electrical wirings and turn-off lights.
9. Formulate fire safety and control measures for contractors as they can increase the risk of fire and cause obstruction to escape routes.
10. Ensure the provision of fire safety and protection equipment, which should not be limited to fire extinguishers. Other equipment may include pails, hose, etc.
11. Conduct regular FIRE DRILLS.
