1. This Office informs all concerns that the Provisions of Technical Assistance (TA) in the Selection and Screening of Science Investigatory Projects (SIP) Proposals shall be conducted on March 7, 2024 at Lamao NHS, Limay, Bataan, and March 8, 2024 at Orani NHS, Orani, Bataan.
2. The TA serves as a venue for knowledge sharing, community engagement, and collaboration among students, teachers, coaches, researchers, and science experts. The SIP activities include the four (4) major categories such as Life Science, Physical Science, Robotics & Intelligent Machines, and Mathematics & Computational Science.

- The project proposals will be screened according to the following criteria:

Originality and Innovation	40%
Technical and Scientific Merit	20%
Community Connection and Impact	20%
Excellence of Method	<u>20%</u>
Total	100%
- The participation of teachers and students shall be subject to the no-disruption-of classes policy stipulated in DO No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the Policy on Off-campus Activities stated in DO No. 66, s. 2017.
- All expenses relative to the conduct of the Science Investigatory Projects can be charged to local funds/School MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

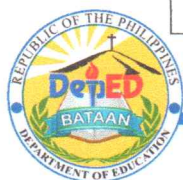
