

REFERENCING IN THE ONLINE WORLD

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The pandemic has triggered shifting of educational approach from face to face to online in just a snap. Besides, referencing could give more reliability, truthfulness, and persuasion to the writing than those plain narratives without citations. This only means that even just reading an article to get a simple idea must be given proper credits, be it in written or oral form.

Referencing is very easy. This is why a lot of educators do not see the logic of why students tend to ignore citations when devising their own works. The Study Space (2022) emphasized the key elements of citation which basically includes the author and publication details as well as the materials used. For books, journals, magazines and similar sources, date of publication, title of the article and the title of the publication, authors, volume and page, as well as place of publication must be included in the reference. For websites, the links must be included as well as the date of access. Such references could be written in two forms: in-text (usually author and date in the middle of paragraphs) and end-text (complete citation put at the end of an article or in footnotes).

In an era where technology has transformed complicated tasks into easy ones, citation generators could actually make the world go round. Citation generators are online referencing tools which could properly cite a particular source as a user encodes the right information. The citation will automatically be formatted depending on what type (APA, MLA, Chicago etc.). Depending on the format, one may access the APA Citation Generator, MLA Citation Generator, Turabian Citation Generator, to name a few (BibGuru, 2022). This will shorten the time spent for referencing and will enable the students or users to perform other necessary tasks.

Technology has made everything way too easy. From the very critical systematic handwritten referencing using books to just copying and pasting the website just to get a formatted reference, internet has changed the way citation is done. This only proves that at least, life has been practically easier and that learners must have to excuse in not citing researchers and authors as the sources of their outputs. Considering this leniency of the online world, students should still never forget that back then and until now, citing the reference remains the most essential part of any writing because as they become professionals, they would have to encounter the notion that credits must be given to where they are due.
