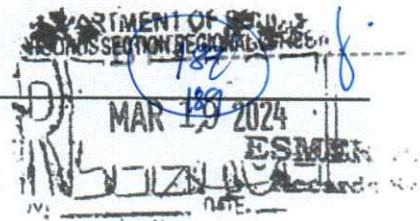

**REGIONAL MEMORANDUM**No. 191, s. 2024**2024 CENTRAL LUZON REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (CLRAA) MEET**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 43, s. 2016, Rule II Section 11 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10588 or the Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013, DepEd Regional Offices shall organize the Regional Athletic Association (RAAs) which shall supervise the conduct of the local meets and organize their respective regional delegations to Palarong Pambansa. Thus, Department of Education Regional Office III through the Central Luzon Regional Athletic Association (CLRAA) announces the conduct of the 2024 (CLRAA) Meet on April 27- May 3, 2024 to be hosted by the Provincial Government of Tarlac Province and the Schools Division of Tarlac Province at Jose V. Yap Sports and Recreational Complex, San Jose, Tarlac Province.

2. The Schedule of the activities are as follows.

May 3 - 2:00 pm	Closing Program	Jose V. Yap Sports and Recreational Complex

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3. The objectives of the 2024 CLRAA Meet are: 1.) to select athletes who will represent the region in the 2024 Palarong Pambansa; 2.) to inculcate discipline, teamwork, and excellence; and 3.) to promote sportsmanship and camaraderie among the athletes of the twenty (20) Schools Divisions in the region.

4. Among the identified sports, Dancesport will remain a demonstration sports. The Olympic Medal System shall be applied to determine the general championship. Awarding of medals to winning athletes will commence immediately after each event or the day's competition. Tournament Managers shall facilitate the awarding of medals.

5. The DepEd Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall organize their respective athletic delegation comprising the best student-athletes and coaches from both public and private schools. Also, each SDO should have a Child Protection Committee.

6. The conduct of the 2024 CLRAA Meet shall be guided by the applicable guidelines stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 035, s. 2023 "2023 Palarong Pambansa General Information, and the Technical Rules, Regulations, and Guidelines on Sports". And it shall also be guided by applicable ground rules approved by the Technical Management and Administration Committee (TMAC).

7. Schools Divisions must adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 entitled DepEd Child Protection Policy and DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2013 entitled IRR of Republic Act No. 10627 Anti Bullying Act of 2013. Enclosure No. 3, Guidelines on the Health and Safety Protocols, Learners Rights and Protection, and Disaster Risk Reduction Management Relative to the Conduct of 2023 Palarong Pambansa of DepEd Memorandum No. 005, s. 2023 "Conduct of 2023 Palarong Pambansa. As such, schools divisions delegation officials shall be held responsible for the protection, welfare, and safety of their pupil/student-athletes. And in compliance to the said orders the following guidelines shall be observed in the conduct of each sport event.

a) Schools Division Superintendents and Division Sports Officers are responsible in the conduct of their delegation especially when their team/s are competing and anytime of the day.

b) Any athlete, coach, assistant coach and chaperon involved in any altercation especially physical shall be banned from the CLRAA Meet and Palaro and the player or the team shall be suspended in the entire duration of present CLRAA Meet without prejudice to the filing of appropriate administrative and/or criminal charges against the erring officials and/or athletes in accordance to existing laws, rules and regulations.

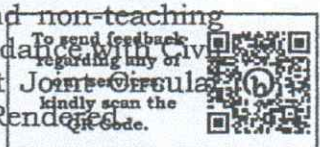






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8. DepEd Order No. 48, s. 2016 Policy Guidelines on Comprehensive Tobacco Control shall be observed on the conduct of the meet.
9. Protest on game technicalities of any sport event and protest on eligibility will be resolved consistent with DepEd's existing policies and guidelines. Complaints shall be in written form, duly signed by the coach and noted by the Head of the Delegation/Division School Sports Officer and shall be accompanied by affidavits of witnesses and /or evidence to support the same and shall be filed before the start of the next game of the concerned team.
10. Tournament Managers (TMs) shall also manage the daily attendance of the officiating officials and submit the same to the Technical Management and Administration Committee (TMAC). They will also submit an evaluation on the performance of the officiating officials. Feedback of the attendance of the officiating officials shall be reported to their respective Schools Division. If there will be officiating officials who are impartial and remiss in the performance of their duty at the same time will be detrimental in the successful conduct of the competitions, TMs have the authority to relieve them on their duty and report the incident to the TMAC for appropriate action. TMs shall also ensure that there are Medical Officers on duty before starting each game.
11. Technical and Officiating Officials who shall serve in the meet must submit a medical certificate (certificate of fitness) taken two (2) weeks before the meet. Only those who are 59 years of age and below shall serve in the meet. No Medical Certificate No Officiating policy shall be strictly enforced.
12. Hosts schools divisions are advised to prepare billeting quarters for the delegations. They are also advise to provide medical personnel to the playing venues and billeting schools.
13. Schools which will serve as billeting schools are encouraged to make necessary steps such as, providing INSETS to teachers, conduct of co-curricular activities or may result to virtual or modular instructions for the learners.
14. Teachers who will serve in the 2024 CLRAA Meet as members of the TMAC, technical or officiating officials, members of the different working committees, coaches, assistant coaches and chaperons shall be granted vacation service credits pursuant to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. And non-teaching personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) in accordance with Civil Service Commission and Department of Budget and Management Joint Circular No.2, s.2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.





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15. Expenses of Schools Divisions incident to this activity shall be charged against local funds and traveling expenses of RO Personnel shall be charged against RO MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
