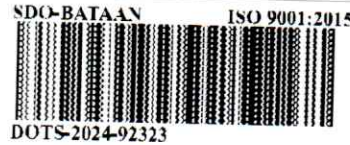

Greetings from SBMA Ecology Center!



SCRAP TO CRAFT CHALLENGE 2023 MECHANICS

1. **Online registration on or before April 15, 2024** (via Google forms link which can be found at SBMA Ecology Center Facebook page or you may call (047)252-4321.
2. Each school can only have **one team composed of 5 members**.
3. Each team should make an item which can be of household use, can be of any dimension, and made up of recyclable materials that should be new and original. The entry should be composed of 70% plastic and 30% recyclable material.
4. Each team must submit a **2-minute video** of their artwork containing at least 5 pictures of the said artwork with explanation of its use, possible impact on community and the materials used and costs spent for the said artwork on or before 5:00 pm of **April 19, 2024** to SBMA Ecology Center (send to ecology@sbma.com and/or asroa@sbma.com)
5. Each team must submit the **actual entry** to SBMA Ecology Center on **April 22, 2024** at 9:00 am -11:00 am and will be judged on the same day.
6. Winning entries will be awarded **on April 24, 2024** by representatives from ABS-CBN Lingkod Kapamilya, DENR Region 3, and Bureau of Customs- Port of Subic.
7. The entries will be displayed **at Ayala Malls Harbor Point from April 22, 2024 until April 26, 2024**.
8. **Criteria for judging** are as follows:

Efficient use of recyclable materials	30%
Originality and Innovation	20%
Creativity	30%
Over-All Presentation	20%
Total	100%

9. Winners will receive the following:
1st prize: (Php10,000.00)
2nd prize: (Php7,000.00)
3rd prize: (Php5,000.00)

*Non-winners will receive Php1,000.00 as consolation prize.

10. **Awarding will be on April 24, 2024, 14th Recyclables Collection Event Opening Ceremony** at Minigolf Course, SBFZ
