PROJECT PROPOSAL

Project Title

: Capacity Building for the Tobacco-Free Generation and Bataan Youth Health Ambassadors for Students and Youth Leaders in the Municipality of Morong.

II. Date of Implementation

: March 13-15, 2024

III. Proposed Venue

: Nagbalayong National High School, Morong, Bataan

IV. Project Cost and Source of Funds: General Fund (P72,600.00)

V. Project Coverage

: Grade 6, JHS, SHS Student volunteers, Guidance

Counselors, and Nurses from Bataan Healthy

School Setting Pilot Schools.

VI. Background/ Rationale:

The 2019 Global Youth Tobacco Survey (GYTS) results showed that among Filipino students between the ages of 13 and 15, e-cigarette usage is more common than the use of any other tobacco product. One in seven pupils, or roughly 14.1% of those between the ages of 13 and 15, reported using e-cigarettes now. Approximately 12.5% of students in the same age group, or one in eight, presently use tobacco products. Conversely, one in four people (24.5%) has experimented with e-cigarettes.

Realizing the urgency of the situation, the Provincial Government of Bataan initiated an anti-smoking and anti-vaping program for its scholars in 2023 through the Office of the Iskolar ng Bataan and the 1Bataan Health Promotion Board. The program's objective is to encourage the development of healthier future professionals.

In order to maintain and expand this program, the Provincial Governor's Office through Bataan Health Promotion Board, will run a school-based TFG-Peer Facilitators Program in advance of its Tobacco Free Generation Social Movement. This is a proactive endeavor to help the people of Bataan live healthier lives and to establish a tobacco-free environment. The movement seeks to stop youth tobacco and vape use because it acknowledges the detrimental consequences that smoking has on public health.

VII. Project Objectives:

- To have a group of TFG Advocates and YHA's who can assist their fellow students in social, emotional, and academic ways.
- To have people who are knowledgeable about sharing their expertise on numerous health themes, such as healthy lifestyle practices, nutrition, smoking and the Tobacco Free Generation, alcohol usage, drug use, and sexuality.
- To provide Bataan's youth the chance to participate in the ongoing development of a project that serves their people.
