SUBJECT : 67TH ANNUAL NATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING (ANCM)

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 7278 and the Constitution and By-laws governing the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, the National Executive Board (NEB) is pleased to announce the approval of the conduct of the **67TH ANNUAL NATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING (ANCM)** on **15 – 17 May 2024** at the **Garden Orchid Hotel in Zamboanga City**.
2. The conference details are as follows:

PURPOSE

As provided in Section 1, Article V of the BSP National By-laws, the National Council shall be convened annually to:

- Receive reports of the National President and the National Treasurer
- Elect four (4) regular members of the National Executive Board
- Ratify any proposed amendments to the BSP Bylaws (if any)
- Conduct the National Court of Honor and other awarding ceremonies
- Discuss other business as may properly come before the meeting

PARTICIPATION

The official delegates of the conference are the following:

- a. National Executive Board Members
 - b. Regional Chairpersons and Regional Scout Commissioners
 - c. Council Chairpersons and Council Scout Commissioners
 - d. Local Council Executive Board (LCEB) Members
 - e. Council Scout Executives/Officers-In-Charge (observer)
- Other regional and local council officers who wish to attend the conference may do so, as **observers**. Observers may participate in deliberations but they shall have **no right to vote**.

AWARDING CEREMONIES

The awarding ceremonies include (but are not limited to):

- a. Tribute to the Scoutmasters
- b. Outstanding Regional/Council Commissioners
- c. Outstanding Regional/Council Chairpersons
- d. Lorillard Spencer Trophy Award

ELECTION OF REGULAR MEMBERS

- a. Each Local Council shall be entitled to **four (4) votes** only, but will be entitled to one (1) additional vote **for every ten thousand (10,000) of its Scout Membership as of December 2023**. The additional vote(s) shall be cast only by the Head of Delegation. See attached list of Councils with additional votes for every 10,000 Scout Membership as of December 2023.
- b. Participating Council Scout Executives shall be allowed to vote in behalf of the council's voting delegate provided that **he/she is the only official delegate from his/her local council**, and that a **Council Executive Board resolution has been submitted to the BSP National Office not later than 31 March 2024**.

REGISTRATION/CONFERENCE FEE

- a. Attendance and participation for the Local Council's and Regional Scouting Committee Key-Three Officials (Council/Regional Chairmen, Council/Regional Commissioners and Council Scout Executives) are **FREE OF CHARGE**.
- b. For other members of the Local Council Executive Board, each shall pay a conference fee amounting to **Six Thousand Pesos (Php6,000.00)** to cover cost of souvenir items, supplies and meals from 15 May 2024 (afternoon snack) up to 17 May 2024 (lunch). The conference fee **DOES NOT** cover **breakfasts** since they are usually included in the hotel's accommodation.
