1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) shall administer the Southeast Asia Primary Learning Metrics (SEA-PLM) 2019 Main Survey, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2017 titled Policy Guidelines on System Assessment in the K to 12 Basic Education Program.
2. The goal of the SEA-PLM assessment is to measure the learning outcomes of Grade 5 students in Reading, Writing, Mathematics, and Global Citizenship, reflecting ASEA Values, along with the background questionnaires for students, parents, teachers, and school heads to gather basic information about the social and educational contexts for learning.

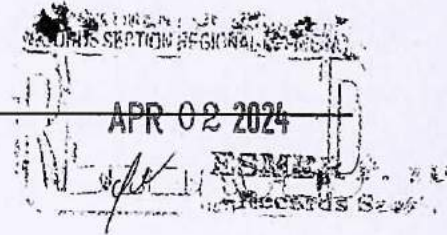
