

Warm greetings from Punlaan School!

We write your good office to introduce our school, and a wonderful once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for your female constituents.

Punlaan School started offering training programs for young women in 1975 and is an accredited Tourism Training Center of the Department of Tourism. It boasts of 49 years of solid track record in training and assisting young women find gainful employment. In 1993, it pioneered the Dual Training System adapted from the German education model. In 2015, the German-Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Inc. granted Punlaan School the "Excellence Award in Vocational Training".

Punlaan School is currently offering two programs:

1. **Post High School Specialization Course in Cooking, Bread & Pastry Production, Food & Beverage and Housekeeping** (for SHS graduates) – one year in-school phase (lecture and hands-on laboratory) and 7-months industry phase (where they are assigned to our partner in the industry – hotel or restaurant).
2. **Apprenticeship Program in Pharmacy Assistant** (for SHS graduate) - 3 months in school Phase (lecture) and 3 months apprenticeship (Watsons Branch near their places).

The program capacitates our students with skills that would enable them to earn the NC Certifications from TESDA. The skills, experience, and certification they earn would make them very eligible for jobs in the hospitality industry. Moreover, all students who are successfully admitted to our programs enjoy a scholarship of free tuition (worth Php190,000). The scholarship also includes free laboratory ingredients. Best of all, upon graduation, our school assists them to find employment in our wide network of hotels and fine dining restaurants.

In the nearly 50 years of Punlaan School's mission of transforming the lives of underprivileged young women, we have graduated and helped over 5,000 girls find gainful employment in the hospitality industry. This translates to 5,000 families, since the majority of our graduates become main breadwinners of their families.




We dream of giving similar opportunities to more young women, especially those in the provinces. We are aware of the fact that several provinces, like your beloved Bataan, are moving to make tourism and hospitality a key industry and therefore generate jobs for your constituents. The main difficulty for these girls from the provinces is the lack of support for their living expenses (food and lodging expenses).

We would like to request the honor of meeting you in person to talk about the possibility of your government assisting these girls from your province to be able to study here in Manila by funding their living expenses. Upon finishing the program, these young women can then return to Bataan to work in the different hotels, resorts and restaurants in the province.
