Garcia, Acting Provincial Governor/ PDRRMC Co-Chairman, dated April 4, 2024, on the Suspension of Face-to-Face Classes for Pre-Elementary, Elementary and High School Level (both Public and Private) in the Province of Bataan on April 5, 2024.
- 3. According to the DOST-PAGASA forecasted temperature report, the temperature in the Province has reached an average heat index that can range from 33°C- 41°C which falls under the Extreme Heat Caution classification. Hence, schools are directed to shift to Alternative Delivery Methods of teaching (Online or Modular) on the aforementioned date.
- 4. In view of this, the NAT Grade 6 shall be administered on April 12, 2024.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination and compliance of the Memorandum is desired.



SUSPENSION OF FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES FOR PRE-ELEMENTARY, ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL (BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE) IN THE PROVINCE OF BATAAN

1) Reference:

- a. Highest Heat Index data from PAGASA (5-Day Computed and 2-day Forecast) issued 03 April 2024 5 PM
- 2) According to the DOST-PAGASA forecasted temperature report consolidated by the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (PDRRMO), the temperature in the Province has reached an average heat index that can range from 33°C-41°C which falls under the Extreme Caution classification.
- 3) Anent aforesaid references, upon the recommendation of the PDRRMC and to protect the welfare and safety of the public, most especially the pupils, students, teachers, and personnel from the continuous threat of extreme heat due to the prevailing dry season and effects of El Niño, face to face classes for PRE-ELEMENTARY.ELEMENTARY and HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL (JHS and SHS), both Public and Private in the Province of Bataan are SUSPENDED and will shift to Alternative Delivery Methods of teaching (Online or Modular) tomorrow, 05 April 2024.
- 4) Further, our PDRRMO will continue to monitor the heat index of our province thru DOST-PAGASA portals and will make future announcements of suspension accordingly.
- 5) All PDRRMC members under the Response Cluster and Local DRRMO's shall continue to be on Alert Status in anticipation brought about by the impacts of the prevailing weather conditions.
