HUMAN PAPILLOMA VIRUS VACCINE (HPV) SCHOOL/COMMUNITY BASED IMMUNIZATION

- In line with Department Memorandum No. 2015-0146 (Guidelines on the implementation of School-Based Immunization), the Provincial Health Office (PHO) conducted Orientation about Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) held last April 2 & 3, 2024 at The Bunker, Capitol Compound, Balanga City, Bataan. The participants are the Public Schools District Supervisors, selected school heads, district nurses and rural health units personnel.
- 2. This activity aims to:
 - a. orient all parents of Grade 4 female pupils about Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccination; and
 - aims to reduce the incidence of HPV-related diseases, such as genital warts and HPV-associated cancers.
- In line with this, all schools must submit Masterlist of all grade 4 female pupils.
- The orientation and vaccination of HPV will be conducted by the Rural Health Units.
- The target of HPV vaccinations are all female school children enrolled in Grade 4 public schools, aged 9-14 years old.
- 6. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
