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Enclosure 2: Guidelines and Mechanics

SaloTinig: Tanghal Tula

- The spoken poetry must be an original composition with the title. It should be written in Filipino. The use of (Taglish) is not allowed.
- The content of the piece must be relevant to the theme.
- The entry must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme and must not contain any malicious or offensive content.
- Each entry (duet) must have two participants (Elementary Category, Junior High School category, and Senior High School Category).
- Each contestant has to submit the spoken poetry video piece through this One Drive Link: <u>https://tinyurl.com/2024KalikhaEntries</u> on or before April 29, 2024.
- Sounds, instrumental, or musical background is allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant chooses not to have a musical background.
- The overall performance must not exceed three minutes.
- The top three contenders for each category will present LIVE for the final round.
- The video with the greatest number of reactions and shared posts on Facebook will be given a special award.
- The piece must be original. If the submitted piece is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.
- All entries shall be considered property of the SDO BATAAN and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.
- Upon joining the contest, student contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for purposes of publication if they are declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.
- SDO Bataan shall not be liable for any infringement of any intellectual property rights arising from using the entries. If there are third-party claims of such infringement of any intellectual property rights, the contestants hold SDO Bataan free and harmless against such claims.
- The participants of the Top 3 winning entries will receive a certificate of recognition, on the other hand, non-winning participants will receive a certificate of participation.
- The winners will be notified through the Division Memorandum.
- Non-compliance with any of the stated contest rules and mechanics is a
- ground for disqualification.
- The awarding ceremony will be conducted on May 10, 2024, during the 2024 KALIKHA Seminar.

Best Community Eco Project

- Participating schools should initiate or continue community Eco-projects that will promote environmental protection and preservation.
- The project must showcase a strong commitment to long-term sustainability and environmental impact. Should have planes for ongoing maintenance, monitoring, and improvement.
- Projects must actively involve the local community, including other organizations. Submissions should outline collaborative efforts and partnerships established.
- The presentation of the project should be in the form of a video.
- The video should not exceed 5 minutes.
- Each contestant has to submit the video through this One Drive Link: <u>https://tinyurl.com/2024KalikhaEntries</u> on or before April 29, 2024.
- All entries shall be considered property of the SDO BATAAN and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.

Canvass Bag Painting Design (Eco Bag)

- Consisting of 2 to 3 members, 1 entry for Junior HS, 1 for Senior HS, 1 for Elementary, (for Integrated school entry will be under junior HS category)
- Materials to be used are cheesecloth or katsa (Size should be 14" by 16" inches and Tote bag style) and Acrylic paint/water-based paint (used for coloring material).
- The bag can be handstitched, or machine stitched.
- The design should be relevant to the theme.
- There must be a video while making and designing the echo bag must be submitted on or before April 29, 2024 through this One Drive Link: <u>https://tinyurl.com/2024KalikhaEntries</u>
- The video should be in 2 minutes.
- All entries shall be considered property of the SDO BATAAN and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.
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Criteria for Judging:

Uniqueness/Originality - 30% Adherence to the theme - 30% Creativity and artistry - 20% Durability - 20% **Total - 100%**

Digital Poster

- The contest is only for individual categories.
- All entries must be aligned to the theme, "Embracing the Call of Nature: Uniting Youth for Environmental Action."
- One (1) entry for junior high school and one (1) for senior high school per school. If the school is integrated, only one entry is allowed.
- The size of the poster must be 46cm by 61cm.
- Use the Ibis Paint X app to create the poster.
- When creating the poster, submit two videos—the screen recording and the actual video.
- Submit video oral presentation explaining the concept of the poster and also attach an MS Word. The video should be in 2 minutes maximum.
- There must be a video while creating the poster must be submitted on or before April 29, 2024 through this One Drive Link: https://tinyurl.com/2024KalikhaEntries
- All entries shall be considered property of the SDO BATAAN and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.
- Upon joining the contest, student contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for purposes of publication if they are declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.
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Criteria for Judging:

RELEVANCE TO THE THEME – 35% GRAPHICS ORIGINALITY – 25% CREATIVITY AND PRESENTATION – 20% COLOR HARMONY - 20% **TOTAL - 100%**

NATURE VLOG

- This contest is open to all schools within SDO- BATAAN. Only one entry per school per category will be accepted. (1 – elementary, 1- JHS, 1- SHS). In case the school is integrated, their entry will be submitted as an entry to the JHS category.
- The vlog should run for a minimum of 4 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes. Failure to follow the prescribed time will mean a 2-point deduction in the total score.
- The vlog must have a title. The name of the school must be the file name.
- The video must be conducted within the community of the school.
- The Nature Vlog must be submitted on or before April 29, 2024, through this One Drive Link: <u>https://tinyurl.com/2024KalikhaEntries</u>
- All entries shall be considered property of the SDO BATAAN and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.
- The Vlog must be encoded on commonly known video file compressions or formats such as .mp4, .avi, and .mkv.
- If the link is broken/defective or not accessible, the submitted entry will no longer be included in the competition.
- Upon joining the contest, student contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for purposes of publication if they are declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.
- The participants of the Top 3 winning entries will receive a certificate of recognition, on the other hand, non-winning participants will receive a certificate of participation.
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Criteria for Judging:

Content - 30% Uniqueness and creativity - 30% Relevance to the theme - 25% Locality - 15% **Total – 100%**
